- Having seen Royal Decree No. NS/RKT/0704/124 dated July 15, 2004 regarding the Appointment of the Royal Government of Cambodia;
- Having seen Royal Kram No. 02/NS/94 dated July 20, 1994 promulgating the Law on the Organization and Functioning of the Council of Ministers;
- Having seen Royal Kram No. CS/RKM/0300/10 dated March 10, 2000, promulgating the Law on Audit of the Kingdom of Cambodia;
- Having seen the Information of Prime Minister of the Royal Government of Cambodia

PROMULGATE

The Law on Amendment to the Law on Audit of the Kingdom of Cambodia was enacted by the National Assembly on July 27, 2006 at its extraordinary session of the third legislature and approved by the Senate on all of its forms and legal concepts on August 09, 2006 at its extraordinary session of the second legislature and was examined and decided to be conformed with the Constitution by the Constitutional Council, by decision No. 081/008/2006kbt.ch date 18 August 2006 and it entirely stated as follows:

**Law on
Amendment to Article 18 of the Law on Audit of the Kingdom of Cambodia**

Article 1:

Article 18 of the Law on Audit of the Kingdom of Cambodia, promulgated by Royal Kram No. CS/RKM/0300/10 dated March 03, 2000 as follows:

Article 18:

The Auditor-General and the Deputy Auditor-Generals shall be appointed by royal decree on the recommendation of the Royal Government and approved by the majority plus-one of all members of the National Assembly.

The Auditor-General and the Deputy Auditor-Generals shall be appointed for a term of five (5) years and may be reappointed for another five (5) year term only upon the completion of the first term.

In case of the Auditor-General or the Deputy Auditor-General(s) die(s), resign(s), disable(s) or commit(s) serious mistake, a new Auditor-General or Deputy Auditor-General(s) shall be appointed under the terms and conditions stated in this Law.

The Auditor-General shall have rank and privileges equivalent to a Senior Minister and the Deputy Auditor-General shall have rank and privileges equivalent to a Minister.

Article 2:

This Law is promulgated urgently.
